A box of shoes was about to be sent to Amazon.com, the company's main customer, which receives the shoes in the U.S. three to five days after making its order. The company's name is SoleRebels. "We are sitting in Addis Ababa here in Ethiopia, but acting like an American company," said Alemu, a 30-year-old former accountant who is excited by her company's rapid growth.
